In 1974 four Shriners conceived the idea of forming a Jeepster parade unit within Mocha Temple and were given permission by the Potentate. In 1975 the unit was officially established with four charter members, Nobles Al Yeo, Bill Gatecliffe, Bill O’Neil and Bob Robertson.

The Unit eventually grew to 25 members.

Every member owns and maintains his own Jeepster. These vehicles were manufactured in Toledo, Ohio from 1948 to 1951 and are maintained to exacting standards with paint colours and accessories that are identical.

The gratuities raised by this parade unit including the import and sale of Vidalia Onions are used to support Shriners Childrens Hospitals and Shrine activities.
